

## Discover a park: Rivercrest Park offers playground for children, picnic pavilion

Rivercrest Park is a delightful neighborhood park with fantastic playground attractions for kids, a beautiful shaded picnic pavilion and a gravel trail that provides a nice walk around the park.

Add in the basketball court and wall ball court, and you'll find something here for just about everyone.

Kids will find the playground equipment an adventure that lasts for hours. Moms, like Kimberly Nagy, enjoy bringing their kids here from as far away as Shasta Lake City.
