Shasta Safe Routes to School’s involvement in Walk to School Day

The Safe Routes to School Program is a federal program directed at improving the health and well being of children by encouraging them to safely walk and bicycle to school. The Shasta Safe Routes to School Program offers safety and promotional items to PTA/parent clubs who commit their school to participating in the 20th Annual **International Walk to School Day on October 5, 2016**. If the school does not have a PTA/parent club, site councils are welcome to apply. Walk to School Day is a day when communities from all over the globe come together to celebrate a child’s active and safe trip to school. Participation in Walk to School Day 2015 reached a record high, with over 5,034 events registered from all fifty states and the District of Columbia. Locally, 14 schools participated with over 1,700 walkers!

Successful applicants will receive safety equipment, technical support, training, and a tool kit with information on how to safely and effectively implement Walk to School Day and on-going walking programs.

Requirements for applicants include: parental involvement, attendance at an orientation meeting, and participation in Walk to School Day. See short list of activities to be coordinated, *Activities Checklist* on page 2.

Walk to School Day Goals:

- Encourage children to walk to and from school (from home or a local gathering place)
- Increase awareness of the importance of regular physical activity
- Mobilize schools and neighbors to work together to make the streets more pedestrian and bike friendly

Walk to School Day Benefits:

- Increased levels of daily physical activity
- Friendlier neighborhoods as people get out and interact with one another
- Safer streets and neighborhoods
- Fewer cars traveling through the neighborhood
- Less traffic at school pick-up and drop-off points
- Improved air quality reducing the risk of respiratory problems

Activities to be coordinated for Walk to School Day:

- Attend** Walk to School Day orientation and planning meeting on Sept. 8, 2016. Meeting will give tips on planning an event, share success stories, and give organizers an opportunity to plan their event. One lucky attendee will win a live radio remote at your school on Walk to School Day!
- Designate** a parent/teacher to act as project coordinator for Walk to School Day activities. Assemble a team/committee of parents and/or staff to help implement Walk to School Day.
- Develop** a plan to promote Walk to School Day to students, parents, school staff, and the community.
- Coordinate a Walking School Bus** (walking school busses are supervised groups of children walking to school), see:

- Hold** a Walk to School Day event **on October 5, 2016**, or a day in October that works best for your school. *Event must take place before the start of the school day to simulate walking to school.*
