


Cognitive Effects of Exercise

How Many Kids Walk to School?



All Students Can Walk/Roll

- Ideal for <1 mile from school to walk from location
- Walking to Bus Stop
- Arrange Bus Drop-offs
- Walk the track before school



Partners

- Principal/superintendent/admin involved
- Invite school board members
- Parent involvement/PTO/PTA prizes, challenge
- Neighborhood Association Nextdoor
- Elected officials
- Businesses health club, churches, etc to contribute toward discounts, volunteers

Promoting the Event

- Staff meeting get teachers excited and involved
- Principal/VP special classroom announcements
- Connect Ed text/phone message
- School App
- Flyers posted for students
- Website
- Reader board
- Banners



Fun Ways to Promote

- A-frame sign in pick up loop
- Tag onto other events
- Students prepare signs (to hang up, or carry along the way)
- Chalk art/footprints
- Think 3-D: shoes hung up
- School Mascot greeting students



Making Your Walk Safe

- Observe morning drop-off
- Choose a safe route
- Pre-Walk Route!
- Address hazards before event
- Use SRO or law enforcement to help with walk, crossing at intersections
- Give families safety rules before walk






